David Lang - "Our Common Fate" (L.A. Master Chorale) - this piece reminded me that the spirit is always alive. A sustained voice has a repetitive motive, that represents the Human Earth rotations, yet the Spirit of peace and time continuum is eternal. Reverent realizations.

Robert Schumann - "Arabesque in C"

Mahler - "Flower piece" ( processing the day-to-day, while "whistle while we work", with various perspectives to add to the same Melody, as it goes through a journey of understanding - Easy Does It.

J.S. Bach - "Aria in the Italian Manner" BWV 989

William Walton - "Crown Imperial" (triumphant Spirit vibes)

Emily Von Sauer - "Piano Concerto # 1 in E" - 3rd movement (was a student of Franz Liszt)

William Grant Still - "Suite for violin and piano"

Poulenc - "Sinfonietta" (andante)

Faure - Barcarolle # 6 (the sustained closeness of even "leading tones", the seventh pitch in a scale, speaks to the need for respectful assertions of community conversations)

Anatol Liadov – The Enchanted Lake - op 62 (Contemplative Evolutional Healing)
